International Player last 3 Years (Test Full Member Nations)

6 Points

Overseas First-Class Cricketer in last 3 Years

5 Points

Australian First-Class Cricketer in last 3 Years

Non-Australian (Import over 21) as per our definition LC1 (1.43.12)

International Player last 3 Years (Associate Member Nations)

4 Points

Australian (Under 21) First-Class Cricketer in last 3 Years

Non-Australian (Import Under 21) as per our definition LC1 (1.43.12)

25+ games of Premier 1st grade in last 3 Years (Not including T/20's)

Played 25 matches of 1st Grade CAW Provincial ODI games for another club over the last 2 seasons.

Any Non-Australian Resident playing cricket anywhere in Australia and then transferring to a CAW Club

3 Points

Anyone on an Australian Specialised/Skilled Work Working Visa

Anyone on an Australian Student Visa (Check Guidelines and Penalties)

24 or less games of Premier 1st grade in the last 3 Years (Not including T/20's)

Played 24 or less games of 1st Grade CAW Provincial games for another club over the last 2 seasons

2 Points

Any other player that didn't play juniors at your club and not mentioned above.

1 Point

Played juniors at the club.

Current club junior.

Played 75 Senior matches at your current club (1st, 2nd or 3rd Grade)

0 Points

Has been a junior player (20 Matches) at your club and then has gone on to play 200 Senior matches at the same club.



Notes:

* Players to lose a point every 2 years of service until they become **1 or 2 pointers** at current CAW Club

*What points you start the season with you will finish the season with.

POINTS allowed maximum 26.

1.43.12 Non-Australian Import

A Non-Australian Import is defined as anyone who comes into Australia specifically to play cricket for any club.

Note: A player will **not be considered** a Non-Australian Import if they are out here on an Australian Working Visa or an Australian Student Visa or are an Australian resident or have made a valid application to the department of home affairs to become a permanent resident of Australia.

Importantly the CAW Club that the player represents must make an application to the CAW Board to confirm the status of any player applying for permanent residency. Any player who does not fit the above criteria will be deemed a Non-Australian Import in line with rule 1.43.12.

Note: Any CAW Club that has a player playing cricket at their club on an Australian Specialised/Skilled Work Working Visa must supply a copy of the Visa to the CAW Board on Request

Note: Any CAW Club that has a player playing cricket at their club on an Australian Student Visa must verify the following to the CAW Board

1. Proof of enrolment in an Australian Educational Institution within 120 Kilometres of Albury
2. Proof of the new financial requirement by the Australian Government
3. Proof that the course will be running through the CAW Season

Failure to comply with the above will have the following consequences.

1. Loss of all premiership points for that side for the season
2. Loss of 4 points from your player points for 2 years

Note: If you play an illegal alien as defined by the Australian Government you will forfeit all points for that grade for the year.
